*Readmitted graduate students will be notified of their tuition charges after readmission applications are submitted to graduate school.

※ Returning students (students previously enrolled at KU & looking to return, including readmitted student) must pay tuition in August.

3. Printing Tuition Bills

KUPID→ Tuition Payment/Scholarship→ Tuition Bills→ Optional Payments

(select or cancel) → Print Bills

✕ Readmitted students must print bills through a bill print shortcut on the school website

- a. Students must check the Other Payments section and select (or cancel) optional payments before printing tuition bills.
- b. Tuition must be paid in a lump sum. Future additional payments or other payments are non-refundable.

*If the bill printing screen is blank, close all Internet windows and reopen them.

(Chrome is recommended for printing invoices.)

2 Payment in Installments

1. Eligible Applicants

- Students who have paid for the first installment after submitting payment in installments application online within the application period*
 - The following students are NOT eligible for payment in installments:
 - a. Freshmen, transfer students, readmitted students, and students on a leave of absence in the first semester of 2025
 - b. Students registering for an additional semester of less than 9 undergraduate credits and less than 3 graduate credits in Fall 2025 (more than 5 general graduate semesters and more than 9 undergraduate semesters)
 - c. Research students who have completed their graduate courses (completed-research students)
- * All students with scholarships amount less than 25% of their tuition without any scholarship reductions are eligible.

6. Amount of Payment in Installments

First Payment	25% of tuition fees+ Other optional fees
Second and Third Payments	25% of tuition fees
Fourth Payment	25% of tuition fees – scholarship amount (will be deducted or separately awarded)

7. Notice

- Students who have made the first payment must make the second, third, and fourth (final) payments.
- Students who have made the first payment are considered enrolled students.
- If the final payment is not made, the student's enrollment will be canceled, and the first, second, and third payments will not be returned.
- If tuition is not paid in full by the payment deadline, the student will be expelled from school pursuant to relevant regulations.
- If students who have made the first, second, or third payments wish to withdraw or take a leave of absence from school, they must pay the remaining balance in full. (Tuition refund regulations for withdrawing students will be applied later.)

- f. Scholarship recipients (students who have applied for payment in installments of less than 25% of tuition) will receive the fourth bill with the amount due after the scholarship deduction has been applied.
- g. If a student does not pay his or her tuition within the designated period, he or she will not be eligible to pay in installments for the following semester.
- h. If you don't pay in the first payment period, your installment is canceled.**

8. Application Procedure for Online Payment in Installments

- a. KUPID → Login → Tuition Payment/Scholarship → Tuition Payment in Installments Application
- b. Click Application after reading the instructions regarding payment in installments.
- c. Check personal and guardian's information. Make corrections if needed.
- d. Complete application by clicking the checkbox for guardians' consent after consulting with guardians. Type in a guardian's cell phone number. (A guardian's consent is not required for graduate students.)
- e. Print out your bill by clicking Payment in Installments Bill for the given period after receiving approval for payment in installments.
- f. Make payments within the designated period.
- g. Students wishing to cancel payment in installments must click Cancel Payment in Installments before making the first payment. (They must then print out a regular tuition bill during the tuition payment period and pay tuition in full.)
- h. Approval for payment in installments is made by tuition-related offices (college administration offices and department offices).

3 Tuition Payment for Extra Semester Students

1. Eligible Applicants

- a. For undergraduates, students in their ninth or later semesters
 - For the Department of Architecture in the College of Engineering, this is for students enrolled in at least 11 semesters.
 - Dual degree students in their third or later semester after their major fields have been determined
 - Transfer students in their fifth or later semester
- b. For the Graduate School students in their fifth or later semester
 - For the master's/doctorate integrated program, students in their ninth or later semester
 - Research students who have completed their graduate courses are excluded.

c. For the Specialized Graduate School or Professional Graduate School, students over regular semesters

※ All the details except the eligibility above are in accordance with the Korea University and Graduate School Regulations.

※ "Extra semester students" are students who do not earn the required number of credits in the regular course completion period (8 semesters for undergraduates and 4 semesters for graduate students) and must enroll in an additional semester to earn the remaining credits needed to graduate.

2. Check your status (No need to Apply)

5. Notice

- a. Application for Student Doing Extra Semester(s) is approved by college administration offices only when final course credits and tuition type match.
- b. Tuition bills can be printed out after the college approval period.
- c. Applicants for a leave of absence should not apply for student's doing extra semester(s) in the relevant semester. They must apply when they return to school.

4. For Students Who Have Completed Courses Before 2014 and Prepaid Thesis Examination Tuition:

- a. Students who did not apply for a thesis examination: 7% of tuition + other payments (medical expense deductions)
- b. Students who applied for a thesis examination: 0% of tuition + other payments (medical expense deductions)
- * Students with bills from KRW 0 must visit Hana Bank in person to report their bills.

5 Payment Methods and Confirmation (Common)

1. Payment Method by bank transfer

- a. Transfer the full amount of tuition (including other payments) to the individual Hana Bank account designated on the tuition bill through any nationwide bank, ATM, Internet banking, or phone banking.
 - Divided transfers are unavailable. Students must check their transfer limits beforehand (e.g. ATM limit for each transfer and Internet banking transfer limits).
 - Transfers through other banks may incur transfer fees.
- b. The remitter does not have to be the student, but payment must be made via the student's virtual account*.
- c. If a full scholarship student does not select an optional payment item (actual billing amount: KRW 0), the student must visit Hana Bank in person.

*Virtual Account: KU assigns a virtual account number to each student. If the amount deposited in the virtual account matches the tuition billing amount, the tuition payment process for the student is automatically completed.

Banking procedure

◎ Hana Bank Internet Banking

Hana Bank website→ Individual Internet Banking Certificate Login→ Bills→ College Tuition Fee→ Select a School→ Type Student ID Number

◎ Hana Bank ATM, Phone Banking → Bills→ College Tuition Fee→ Select a School→ Type Student ID Number

Payment error cases include omission of mandatory payments, divided transfers, inaccurate transfer amounts, and inaccurate account numbers.

2. Payment method by Samsung Credit Card

- a. Payment can be made through Samsung Card's Website(web/app) and call center (☎1688-9702) Payment time: 9:00 to 16:00
- b. It's not possible to pay part of your tuition fee payment (including other payments) in cash and part by card.
- c. Any credit card holder (students themselves, parents, and acquaintance card) can make the payment.
- d. Tuition payment amount is excluded from credit card usage amount when deducting tax returns.
- e. Credit card payment cannot be cancelled.

3. Payment method by Hana Credit Card

- a. Payment can be made through Hana Bank's website(web).
- b. Credit card payment method is not allowed for transfer students, readmitted students, students doing extra semesters or students that use installment payments.
- c. Payment cannot be made in cash, therefore tuition fee payment (including other payments/optional fee) must be transferred in full.
- d. Tuition payment amount is excluded from card usage amount when deducting tax settlement.
- e. Any credit card holder (students themselves, parents, and acquaintance card) can make the

- payment.
f. Card payment cannot be cancelled.

4. Payment Confirmation

- a. Tuition Payment Status: Check 10 minutes after payment

KUPID → Tuition Payment/Scholarship → Check Tuition Payment Status in the Tuition Payment Details Section

The tuition payment details show the billing amount only. To print out a receipt for tuition payment, use the following method:

- b. Tuition Payment Receipt: Check 10 minutes after payment

KUPID → Information/Life → Internet Certificate System → Certificate Request → Print Tuition Payment Certificate (An educational expenses payment certificate is required for an income tax exemption for year-end tax adjustment.)

5. Inquiries About Tuition Payments

- a. Since virtual account deposit and bill printing are only available during the tuition payment period, students must make any inquiries within that period. Information regarding tuition charges and payments can be found at the following:

1. Healthcare Expenses

For disease prevention and the promotion of student health, medical treatment, medication, and health screening services are provided by school doctors.

3. Alumni Association Fees

Along with alumni association membership, annual alumni association fees paid by students are used for scholarship funding, the publication and distribution of alumni association newsletters, and school sponsorships. As part of an initiative to support our alma mater, a fee of 50,000 KRW will be charged to students enrolled in the second semester of their fourth year. (optional)

4. Student Council/Newsletter Fees

Student council/newsletter fees are used for student council operation and newsletter publication. (optional)

5. Korea-Yonsei Game (Ko-Yon Games) Support Fund
